- Equipping- Quality education by providing them with the technology necessary to succeed.
- Protection - To safeguard children's rights, young girls and child mothers from child marriages, teen pregnancies, abusive relations and neglect.
- Prevention-To educate the community in issues of public health, subsistence agriculture and income generation.
- Reintegration- Empower them with tools, Skills ,Knowledge and Start-up capital.

We are thrilled to report that our organization is growing slowly but steadily.



- We managed to finish constructing a home that is being used as classrooms, built a farmers house, ,And installed solar security lights.

- Currently, we are empowering over 320 orphans and underprivileged children in our community by offering educational opportunities and essential resources, including school supplies

- Planted 5 acres of corn which we have harvested yield corn and growing a 1 acre of garden to help us in the feeding program.

- installed solar water pump and tank that clean and safe water to all our children and staffs and built 6 toilets in order to reduce the spread of diseases and improve sanitation.

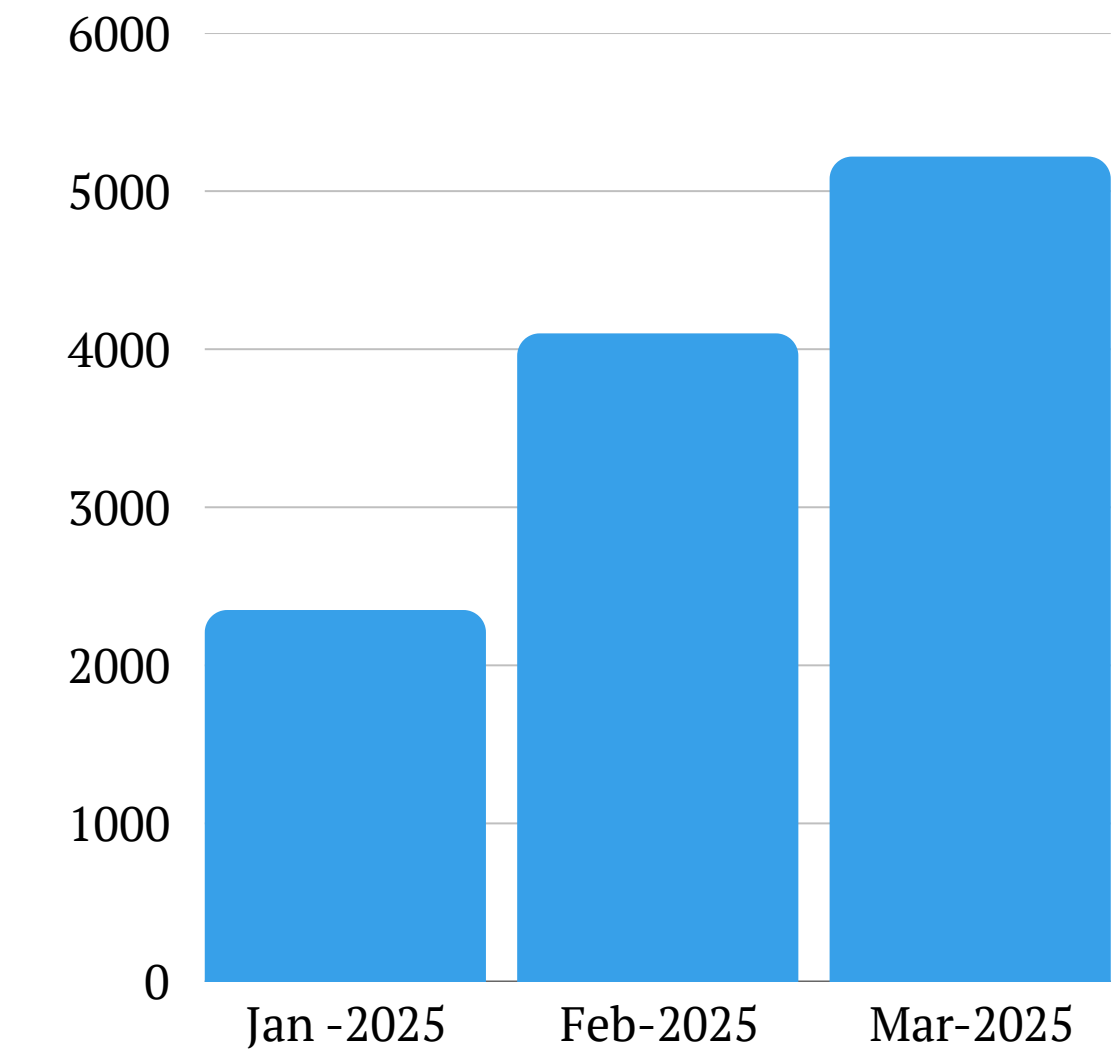

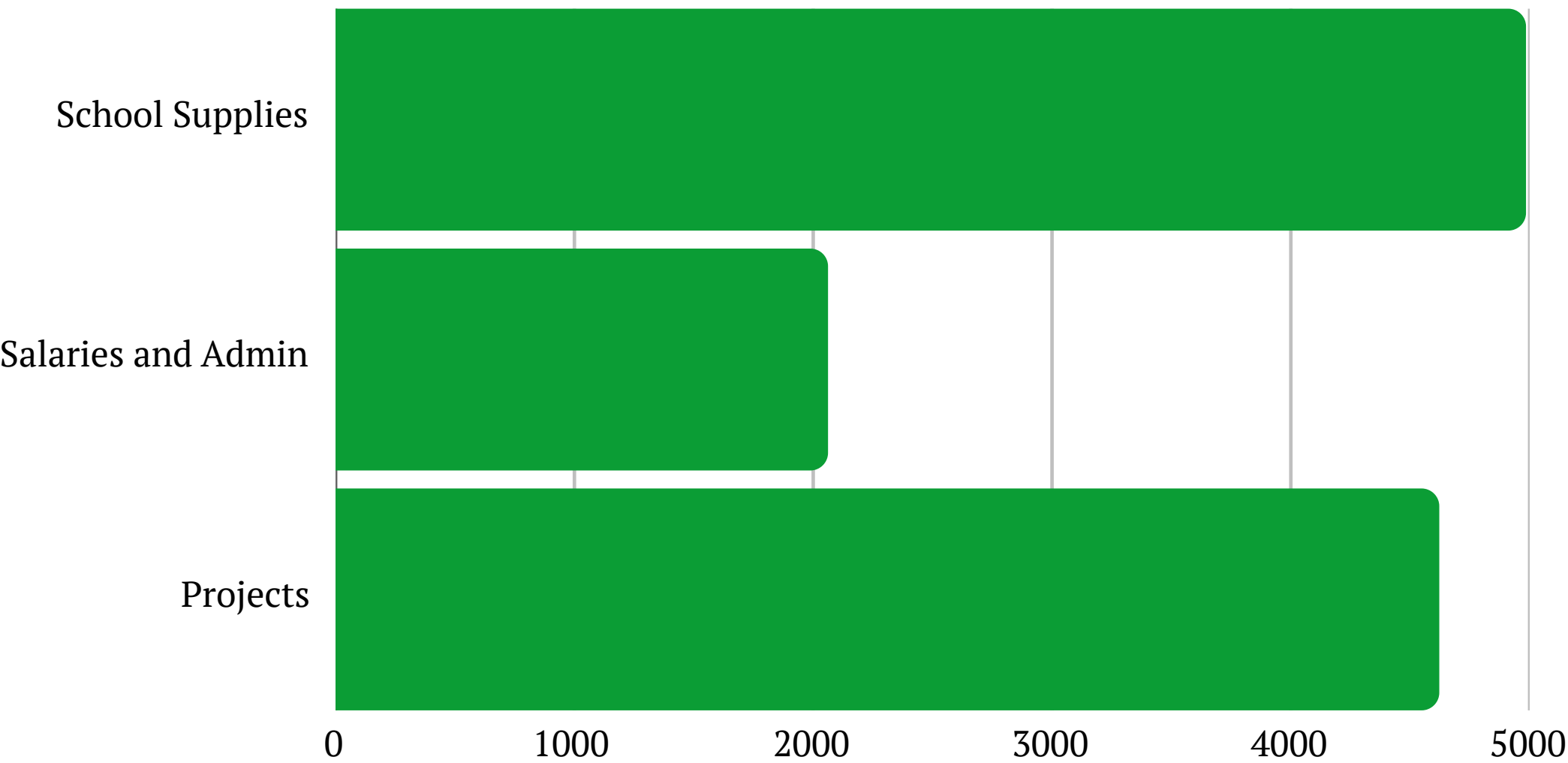
6.FUNDING IMPACT
